

# webbug-reader.pdf

When opened, this PDF connects to "home"

Click "Allow" to connect to <http://localhost/webbug-reader.php> through your current Reader.

## Comments:

1. Open this pdf document (webbug-reader.pdf)
2. The Reader connects to \${url}
3. The web server returns the requested page:

```
<?php
    header('Content-type: application/pdf');
    readfile('calc.pdf');
?>
```
4. The Reader receives "calc.pdf" which is immediatly rendered
5. A pop-up ask if it can execute the calc...

Note: The URL where the Reader tries to connect is displayed

## Windows:

- Foxit : Nothing happens.
- Acrobat Reader 8: a popup appears for the user to allow the connection,  
then the connection is made and a new window is opened with the 2nd document

## Mac:

- Preview: nothing happens
- Acrobat Reader 8: a popup appears for the user to allow the connection,  
then the connection is made and a new window is opened with the 2nd document

## Linux:

- poppler: /SubmitForm is not supported
- Acrobat Reader 8: a popup appears for the user to allow the connection,  
then the connection is made and a the document window is replaced with the 2nd document

Note: The 2 documents can be seen in the "Window" menu.
